Office & Recycling Depot Reopen to the Public

Our Office and Recycling depot reopened to the public on June 8th. We take the health and safety of our employees very seriously and are asking that you please review the updated Pride policies and reminders before visiting.

- Masks are required: You will be required to wear a mask when you are on Pride property. If you do not have a mask on, you will not be allowed to use our depot or come into our office.
 - **Hand-sanitizer station**: There is a handsanitizer station available for your use at our depot and in the front office.



- **Paying for items**: If you have a depot item that requires payment, we ask that you consider using a credit/debit card or charge the item to your Pride account whenever available. This will limit our need to handle cash or check payments.
- **Items accepted**: The items accepted at the depot have not changed, please visit our depot page for the current list. <u>https://pridedisposal.com/resources/recycling-drop-off</u>
 - **Sign-in information**: We've always asked depot customers to sign-in. The Depot Monitor will now take your sign-in information verbally and record it. This will prevent the need to pass the clipboard and pens back and forth. We are asking the same information as before; name and phone number.
- Front Office: We are asking that you consider visiting our office in-person only if you need to pay for items dropped off at the depot. As always, our office staff is available to assist you by phone or via electronic communication. If you do enter our office, masks are required and only 1 person can be in the lobby at a time. The front desk area will be cleaned regularly during business hours, this includes: credit card machine, customer side of the counter-top, and the front door handle.

Thank you for your continued understanding as we navigate these difficult times. We appreciate your help in keeping our employees and customers safe! If anything changes, we will update our website and social media pages immediately.

Glass & Motor Oil Recycling Tips!

Glass bottles and jars can be placed in your red bin for recycling, they do not belong in your curbside recycling cart. Bottles and jars are the only glass material that is acceptable for recycling. <u>Discard all lids and corks</u> before placing in your bin. Unacceptable items include: mirrors, windows, plates, ceramics, drinking glasses, etc.

The glass in those items are different and cannot be mixed with bottles and jars for recycling.

Motor oil is picked up on the same schedule as your glass recycling. Motor oil must be in a see-through 1-gallon container with a screw lid (such as a milk jug) and cannot be mixed with any other fluids. <u>Do</u> <u>not place oil in the container it came in</u> <u>unless it is see-through</u>.

Motor oil is the only fluid accepted curbside for recycling. If you do not have glass to recycle, please put your motor oil in your red bin or next to it. That way it's easier for the driver see while on route. A jug of motor oil can easily be missed by the driver if it's not out with the red bin.





Pride Document Shredding offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

Pre-paid shred bags for \$5. Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$5 from the Pride office. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you.
