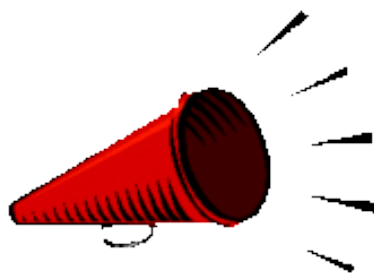

Importance of Bagging Garbage

Please remember to bag your garbage before placing items in your garbage cart and close all bags securely. Our drivers have noticed that lately there have been more customers not properly bagging and securely closing their garbage. Bagging your garbage will help keep material from blowing around and causing litter during the collection process (especially on windy days). The loose garbage can also expose our drivers and your neighbors to your germs.

Help us keep your neighborhoods clean by bagging your garbage and sealing the bag tightly before placing the bags in your garbage cart.



Coming Soon!

We are adding new trucks to our fleet soon! These new trucks are called split-body trucks, meaning they are able to pick up more than one commodity at a time because the hopper has two compartments.

You may see one driver picking up more than one cart at your home at the same time. Don't worry! We aren't mixing your material, it will be going into separate compartments on the truck.

Be on the look-out for these new trucks to hit the road in your neighborhood soon!

Motor Oil Recycling

Motor oil is picked up on the same schedule as your glass recycling. Motor oil must be in a see-through 1-gallon container with a screw lid (such as a milk jug) and cannot be mixed with any other fluids. Do not place oil in the container it came in unless it is see-through. No more than (3) 1-gallon containers are allowed per pick-up. When the motor oil has been properly prepared for pick-up, place next to your red bin.

If you do not have glass to recycle, please put your motor oil in your red bin or next to it. That way it will be easier for the driver to see the oil while on route. A jug of motor oil can easily be missed by your driver if it's not out with the red bin.

No other fluids are allowed curbside. If the driver sees the motor oil has been mixed with another fluid, they will tag the oil and leave it.



DOCUMENT DESTRUCTION

Shred old documents and paperwork securely.

Pride Document Shredding offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

Pre-paid shred bags for \$5. Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$5 from the Pride office. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you. If you have more than one grocery bag size to shred, we also offer a red bin or 60-gallon tote size for shredding on-site.
