**Extra Garbage Bags:** Did you do some cleaning and end up with a few extra garbage bags? We can pick those up! Just place them next to your garbage cart on your pick up day and the driver will pick them up. There is an extra fee for the extra bags, which varies depending on your jurisdiction.

**Extra Yard Debris:** Are you finding you have extra yard debris? We can help! You are able to set out extra yard debris in biodegradable paper bags or a personal tote and we will pick them up. There is an extra fee for the extra bags or 2nd tote, which varies depending on your jurisdiction. You are also able to get a 2nd yard debris tote at your home for a monthly fee.

**Bulky Item Collection:** We collect larger items that don't otherwise fit in your garbage cart such as furniture or appliances. We send a separate truck on your service day to pick these items up so it needs to be scheduled in advance. Contact us for more details on charges and scheduling.

**Drop Boxes and Temporary Containers:** We offer drop box or temporary containers for projects such as: roof replacements, garage clean outs, yard projects and more. **Note:** The 3rd party drop box companies that you may find online have to contact us to order the service because our service areas are franchised. Those companies upcharge you for the services that we are providing, which means the price you pay to them is above the franchised rates set by your jurisdiction. Make sure you contact us directly to avoid being charged more than the rates that have been set in your jurisdiction.



**New Recycle Depot Hours**

Effective January 1, 2022, our recycling depot will be closing for lunch from 12pm—1pm! During this time you will not be able to drop any items off.

The new depot hours will be as follows:

Monday—Friday from 8am—12pm and 1pm—4:30pm

## [New legislation will overhaul Oregon's recycling system](#)

New legislation passed in 2021 that will update Oregon's recycling systems to make recycling more accessible and easier to understand! The Recycling Modernization Act will do several things:


- Statewide Recycling List: Consistency statewide regarding what can be recycled in Oregon.
- Truth in Labeling: There is a taskforce who will work on updating labeling requirements so only items that can be recycled in Oregon can be listed as recyclable. This will reduce customer confusion and increase transparency from producers.
- Product Stewardship: This legislation introduces a shared responsibility model so companies who sell products into Oregon will have a monetary obligation to make sure their products are managed properly and recycled when possible.

Shred old documents and paperwork securely.

Pride Document Shredding offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

**Pre-paid shred bags for \$5.** Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$5 from the Pride office. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you. If you have more than one grocery bag size to shred, we also offer a red bin or 60-gallon tote size for shredding on-site.
