**New materials accepted at Pride depot for recycling!**

Exciting news! Effective 7/11/22, we have added two items to our recycling depot in Sherwood. The new materials can be dropped off (in residential volumes) at no charge and include:

- #1 PET clamshell plastics
- Film plastics

The depot is open Monday through Friday, 8am to 12pm and 1pm to 4:30pm, we are closed daily for lunch from 12pm to 1pm.



**Many clamshells look alike!** They will need to be sorted by number at the depot before they can be dropped off, we recommend you sort them in advance. #1 clamshells will be accepted at no charge. #6 clamshells are accepted along with other #6 plastics, there is a charge of \$5 per car load for any #6 plastic dropped off. No other numbered clamshells can be dropped off at the depot.

If you're interested in recycling #1 PET clamshells, film plastic, or other hard to recycle items curbside, we have a new optional program for an additional charge, Recycle+! Recycle+ is available to Urban Unincorporated Washington County customers only at this time. ## Recycle Right!

Please make sure that only the correct items are included in your curbside recycling. Here is a basic list of items that are accepted in your curbside recycling cart:

- Cardboard (flatten and cut (not fold) into pieces no larger than 3' x 3')
- Scrap paper, magazines, newspaper, chipboard boxes
- Milk jugs, plastic tubs (larger than 6oz, remove lids)
- Plastic bottles, with the neck of bottle smaller than the base (remove lids)
- 5-gallon bucket, handles ok (remove lids)
- Tin, aluminum cans, misc. metal (less than 45lbs and 36")

### On the side! With your red bin.

- Glass bottles and jars (Remove and discard lids. No dishware, drinking glasses, or vases.)
- Motor oil (Place in a clear, 1-gallon container with a screw on lid (like a milk jug). No other fluids accepted. Limit of 3 gallons per service day.)
- Household Batteries (Place in a 1-quart zip-sealed bag and put the full bag in your red bin. Use clear tape to cover both ends of the batteries. No lead acid batteries. Limit of one single 1-quart bag per pick-up.) If you're in The City of Hillsboro or Beaverton battery recycling is not yet available for you. If you need to confirm whether this service is available, please call our office.

Shred old documents and paperwork securely.

Pride Document Shredding offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

**Pre-paid shred bags for \$5.** Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$5 from the Pride office. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you. If you have more than one grocery bag size to shred, we also offer a red bin or 60-gallon tote size for shredding on-site.
