Holiday Pick up Schedule

The only holidays that our drivers do not work are Christmas Day and New Years Day. During those weeks, when the holiday falls on a weekday, pick up will be delayed from the holiday through the end of the week. This year the holidays fall on a Monday so all collection days are impacted. See below for info on schedules for the Christmas and New Years holidays this year:

Christmas Tree Recycling



If you would like to have your Christmas tree collected and you have yard debris service, you can put your tree in your yard debris cart on your scheduled yard debris day. Place the tree inside your yard debris cart (or in place of your cart) and it will be picked up no charge. If you put your tree out in addition to your yard debris cart there is an extra fee. If you do not have yard debris service, please call our office to make arrangements for the tree to be removed.

All trees over 5' must be cut in half. If the tree is over 4' wide, it also needs to be cut down.

All lights, ornaments, etc. must be removed. Wreaths are accepted if all wire framing and decorations are removed. Flocked trees are not accepted as yard debris but can be picked up as garbage.

If you're having a non-profit organization pick up your tree, please do not schedule that pick up on your Pride Disposal pick up day to avoid any confusion.

We accept many items at our depot that you can recycle curbside, as well as additional items that are not recyclable curbside. We accept residential quantities, if you have commercial quantities, please contact us prior to your arrival.

See below for a list of harder to recycle items that we accept, some items for a charge.

Note: This list is subject to change, for the most up to date information please visit our website, or contact our office.

- **Film plastics**
- **#1 PET Clamshell plastics**—must be clear and hinged on one side.
- **Styrofoam**—\$5/carload at our depot. Agilyx in Tigard accepts for free.
- **Televisions, computers, and laptops**—includes towers, keyboards, mice, printers, ink cartridges
- **Miscellaneous electronics**—some charges apply depending on the item.
- **Appliances**—some appliances have a charge, contact us for details.
- **Fluorescent light bulbs**—compact bulbs: \$1.00/each, tubes over 4': \$1.00/each, tubes 4' or less \$.50/each.

[Bagging your garbage is important!](#)

Please remember to bag your garbage before placing items in your garbage cart and close all bags securely. Lately there have been more customers not properly bagging and securely tying those bags. Bagging your garbage helps keep material from blowing around and creating litter during the collection process (especially on windy days). The loose garbage can also create a safety hazard for our drivers.

Help us to keep your neighborhoods clean by bagging your garbage and sealing the bag tightly before placing the bags in your garbage cart.
