**Check out the extra services we offer!**

**Extra Garbage Bags:** Did you do some cleaning and end up with a few extra garbage bags? We can pick those up! Just place them next to your garbage cart on your pick up day and the driver will pick them up. There is an extra fee for the extra bags, which varies depending on your jurisdiction.

**Extra Yard Debris:** Are you finding you have extra yard debris? We can help! You are able to set out extra yard debris in biodegradable paper bags or a personal tote and we will pick them up. There is an extra fee for the extra bags or 2nd tote, which varies depending on your jurisdiction. You are also able to get a 2nd yard debris tote at your home for a monthly fee.

**Bulky Item Collection:** We collect larger items that don't otherwise fit in your garbage cart such as furniture or appliances. We send a separate truck to pick these items up so it needs to be scheduled in advance. Contact us for more details on charges and scheduling.



**Drop Boxes and Temporary Containers:**

We offer drop box or temporary containers for projects such as: roof replacements, garage clean outs, yard projects and more. **Note:** The 3rd party drop box companies that you may find online have to contact us to order the service because our service areas are franchised. Those companies upcharge you for the services that we are providing, which means the price you pay to them is above the franchised rates set by your jurisdiction. Make sure you contact us directly to avoid being charged more than the rates that have been set in your jurisdiction.



**Recycle+:** In addition to your standard curbside recycling service, we offer an optional recycling service for hard to recycle items including: film plastics, #1 PET clamshell plastics (must be clear and hinged on one-side), textiles, and compact fluorescent light bulbs. There is an additional charge for this service, call us to see if this program is available in your area!

## Tote Placement

Our cart collection trucks use an automated arm to service your roll carts, so we are asking that you please take the following into consideration:

- Leave 3-5 feet between each cart whenever possible. This makes it easier for the automated arm to pick up each cart without knocking over the carts next to it.
- Place carts within 5 feet of the curb.
- Do not block bike lanes, vehicle lanes of travel, or sidewalks.
- Make sure there is 18' of overhead clearance from items such as basketball hoops and tree branches.
- Do not place too close to your fence, sprinkler heads, yard lights, or anything else that the driver may not see when picking up your cart and therefore could potentially damage.

It's also important that you **do not block sidewalks** with your carts. People that utilize wheelchairs, strollers, etc. need to be able to safely use the sidewalks, and blocking the sidewalk with your carts creates a hazard.

Whenever possible, place the carts on the street with the wheels of the cart

directly against the curb. We understand this isn't the perfect situation for every street. Other options include:



- Place the carts in the strip of landscaping between the sidewalk and the street.
- Place carts in your yard on the edge of the sidewalk that is closest to your home.
- If there is no sidewalk, place the carts in the street or in the landscaping along the street.

**Aluminum Cans**



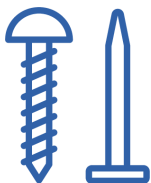
**Tin Cans**
