Common Contaminants found in Recycling and Yard Debris Carts

These are some of the more common contaminants that we see regularly in our recycling and yard debris carts, this list is not inclusive of all the things that are not allowed. Please **do not include** these items in your curbside carts.

Recycling:

- Plastic bags, other film plastics (shrink-wrap, bubble wrap)^
- Clamshell plastics (berry containers)^
- To-go containers
- Styrofoam
- Packing peanuts
- Toilet paper, paper towels, paper plates, napkins, or tissues
- Plastic plates, utensils, cups
- · Pet food bags or fertilizer bags
- Garbage

^We accept film plastic and #1 clamshell plastic (must be clear and hinged on one-side) at our recycle depot for free! Or if you're interested in curbside service for hard to recycle items, we offer an optional Recycle+ service in most of the jurisdictions we service. Yard Debris:

- Plastic bags
- Non-approved compostable bags ^
- "Compostable" to-go containers, cups, or cutlery
- Dirt, sod, rocks, concrete
- Processed wood, lumber, tree stumps
- Animal waste
- Branches longer than 36"
- Garbage

^"Compostable" or "Biodegradable" bags must be BPI certified to be allowed in your curbside yard debris cart.

Check out the extra services we offer!

Extra Garbage Bags: Did you do some spring cleaning and end up with a couple extra bags? We can pick those up! Just place them next to your garbage cart on your pick up day and the driver will pick them up. There is an extra fee for the extra bags, which varies depending on your jurisdiction.

Extra Yard Debris: Are you finding you have extra yard debris? We can help! You are able to set out extra yard debris in biodegradable paper bags or a personal tote and we will pick them up. You are also able to get a 2nd yard debris cart at your home. There is an extra fee for the extra bags or 2nd tote, which varies depending on your jurisdiction.

Bulky Item Collection: We collect larger items that don't otherwise fit in your garbage cart such as furniture or appliances. We send a separate truck on your service day to pick these items up so it needs to be scheduled in advance. Contact us for more details on charges and scheduling.

Drop Boxes and Temporary Containers: We offer drop box or temporary containers for projects such as: roof replacements, garage clean outs, yard projects and more. Note: The 3rd party drop box companies that you may find online have to contact us to order the service because our service areas are franchised. Those companies upcharge you for the services that we are providing, which means the price you pay to them is above the franchised rates set by your jurisdiction. Make sure you contact us directly to avoid being charged more than the rates that have been set in your jurisdiction.



Document Destruction

Shred old documents and paperwork securely.

Pride Document Shredding offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

Pre-paid shred bags for \$7. Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$7 from the Pride Depot. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you.
