Cart Placement

Recently our drivers have reported that some customers may not be placing their carts at the curb correctly. Our collection trucks use an automated arm to service your carts, so proper placement is important to ensure safe and efficient service.

When placing your carts curbside for collection, please take the following into consideration:

- Leave 3-5 feet between each cart whenever possible. This makes it easier for the automated arm to pick up each cart without knocking over the carts next to it.
- Place carts within 5 feet of the curb.
- Do not block bike lanes, vehicle lanes of travel, or sidewalks.
- Make sure there is 18' of overhead clearance from items such as basketball hoops and tree branches.
- Do not place too close to your fence, sprinkler heads, yard lights, or anything else that the driver may not see when picking up your cart and therefore could potentially damage.



It's important that you **do not block sidewalks** with your carts. People that utilize wheelchairs, strollers, etc. need to be able to safely use the sidewalks, and blocking the sidewalk with your carts creates a hazard.

Whenever possible, place carts on the street with the wheels of the cart directly against the curb. We understand this isn't the perfect situation for every street. Other options include:

- Place the carts in the strip of landscaping between the sidewalk and the street.
- Place carts in your yard on the edge of the sidewalk that is closest to your home.
- If there is no sidewalk, place the carts in the street or in the landscaping along the street.

Pride's Recycling Depot

We accept many items at our depot that you can recycle curbside, as well as additional items that are not recyclable curbside. We accept residential quantities. If you have commercial quantities, please contact us prior to your arrival.

See below for a list of harder to recycle items that we accept, some items for a charge.

Note: This list is subject to change, for the most up to date information please visit our website, or contact our office.

- **Film plastics**
- **#1 PET Clamshell plastics**—must be clear and hinged on one side.
- **Propane Tanks**—must be empty
- **Fire Extinguishers**—Free if empty, \$15/each if not empty
- **Televisions, computers, and laptops**—includes towers, keyboards, mice, printers, ink cartridges
- **Miscellaneous electronics**—some charges apply depending on the item.
- **Appliances**—some appliances have a charge, contact us for details.
- **Fluorescent light bulbs**—compact bulbs: \$1.00/each, tubes over 4': \$1.00/each, tubes 4' or less \$.50/each.

Bagging your garbage is important!

We recommend that you bag your garbage before placing items in your garbage cart and that you securely tie all bags.

Recently we have noticed more customers with garbage that is not properly bagged or sealed. Bagging your garbage helps prevent materials from blowing around and creating litter during the collection process, especially on windy days! Loose garbage can also create a safety hazard for our drivers.

Please help us keep your neighborhood clean and safe by bagging your garbage and sealing the bags tightly before placing the bags in your garbage cart.
