

Do you know what do these numbers mean?

Plastic items may have the recycling symbol on them but that doesn't mean the item is recyclable curbside. The number inside the chasing arrows (pictured below) does not designate whether or not it is recyclable curbside, it only designates what type of plastic the item is made from.



Plastics acceptable in curbside recycling include only the following:

- Plastic bottles, with the neck/opening smaller than the base
- Plastic tubs, 6 oz. or larger
- Milk Jugs
- Rigid nursery plant pots, 4" or larger
- Buckets, 5 gallons, or less

Do you have #6 plastics or styrofoam?

We are now accepting all clean #6 plastics (including styrofoam) at our depot in Sherwood. There is a charge of \$5 per car load. This material is NOT recyclable curbside.

Save yourself time when you get here by pre-sorting styrofoam from other #6 plastics as they will need to be separated when they are dropped off. #6 plastics can be items such as cold coffee cups, plastic trays, and more. Check the number inside of the chasing arrows, if it's a 6 and it's clean, bring it to us!

#6 plastics and styrofoam are NOT recyclable curbside

Saturday Recycling & Paper Shredding Event

When? Saturday, September 8th, 9:00am to 12:00pm

Where? Pride Recycling Depot at 13980 SW Tualatin-Sherwood Rd

What can you bring to the event? Full recycling depot will be open for computer monitors, TVs, laptops, printers, various electronics, some appliances, cardboard, commingled recycling, glass bottles/jars, batteries, ink cartridges, cell phones, metal, fluorescent bulbs, #6 plastics, styrofoam, and more! See charges listed below. For a full list of acceptable items visit our website.

Paper Shredding: There will be a food drive in correlation with the paper shredding. All non-perishable food items collected will be donated to Sherwood Helping Hands. See below for more information on how to participate in the food drive portion of the event.

Please note: garbage is not accepted at this event.

Payment accepted via Cash/Check only. No cards accepted.

Chargeable Depot Items include

- \$5 DVD player/VCR, Stereo (per component)
- \$.50—\$1 Fluorescent light bulbs (depending on size)
- \$35 Freon Appliances (fridge, A/C unit)
- \$5 UPS Battery Backup
- \$1 Batteries—per quart (\$1 minimum)
- \$5 Commingled Recycling: scrap paper, #1 & #2 plastic bottles (\$5 per car load, residential vol.)
- \$5 #6 plastics and styrofoam (\$5 per car load, residential vol.)

Paper Shredding:

One brown paper grocery bag of paper FREE with donation of 2 non-perishable food items.

Limit of 1 free bag per car

\$8 minimum fee (includes 1 red bin of paper)

\$8 for each red recycling bin of paper

\$30 for each 60 gallon cart of paper

The shred truck will be on site and material will be shredded during the event.

DOCUMENT DESTRUCTION

Shred old documents and paperwork securely.

Pride Recycling Company offers shredding services at your home or business, with one time, occasional, or regular shredding. Secure drop off is also available at the Pride Depot in Sherwood. Whether at your home or place of business, disposing of intact confidential information is a risk. Contact us to have it shredded and protect yourself and/or your customers from this risk.

Pre-paid shred bags for \$5. Purchase a paper bag (grocery bag size) for \$5 from the Pride office. Take the bag home, fill it with paper to be shredded, and bring it back to the recycling depot to be shredded when it is convenient for you.
